Publications Overview 2015-2016

Since January 2015, the IC² Institute has produced 78 research publications. The focus of these publications includes *entrepreneurial education* (23%), *regional development & emerging regions* (22%), *environmental sustainability* (17%), *technology* (14%), *innovation* (10%), and *policy & society* (11%), as seen in Figure 1 below. This topical array illustrates cutting-edge relevance to today's technologies and economic concerns, even while it continues to reflect the original mission and goals of the IC² Institute.

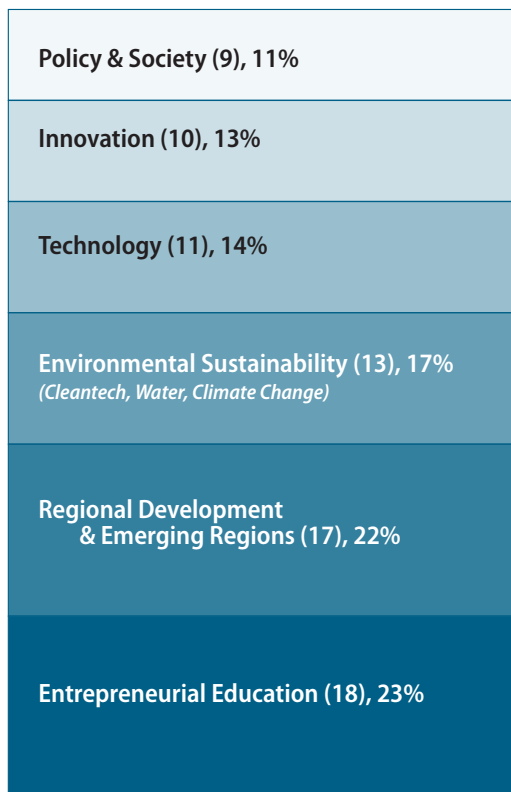
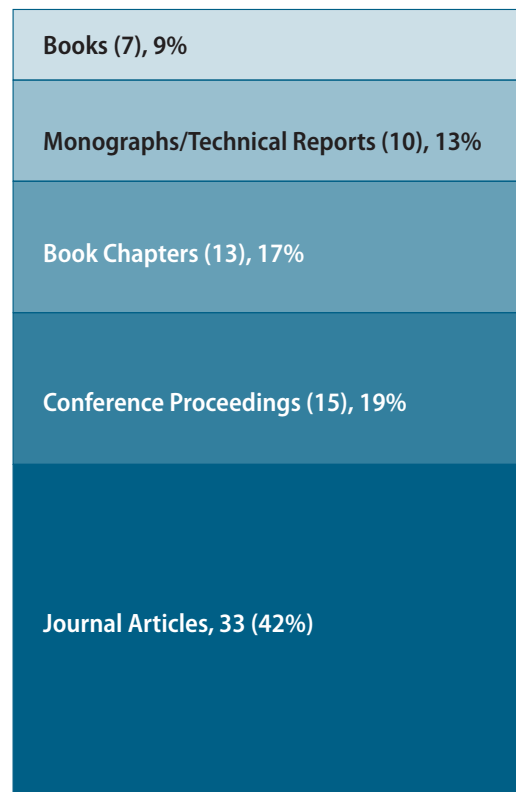


Figure 2. Publications by Type (78 total)

Forty-two percent of these publications appear as refereed *journal articles*, 19% are *conference proceedings*, and 17% are published as *book chapters*, while another 13% are *monographs or technical reports* and 9% are *books* (Figure 2).

Figure 1. Publications by Topic (78 Total)
