

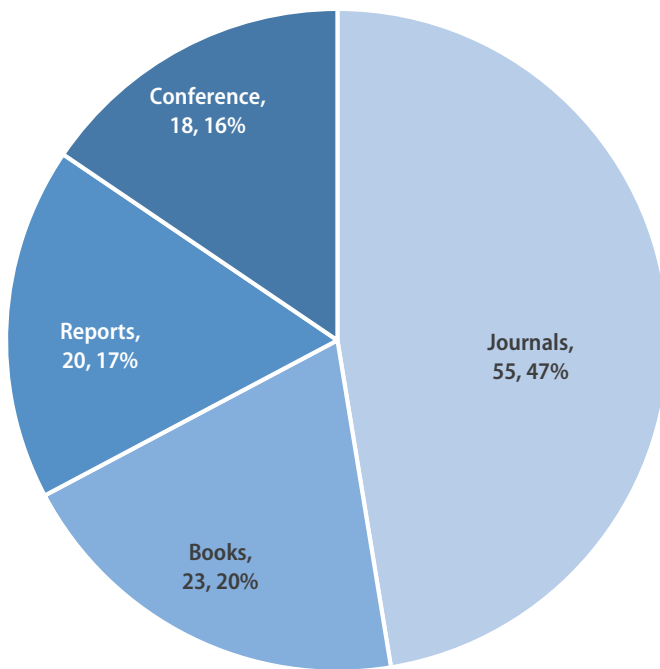
IC² Institute Research Publications Overview 2017-2018

(Report compiled August 13, 2018)

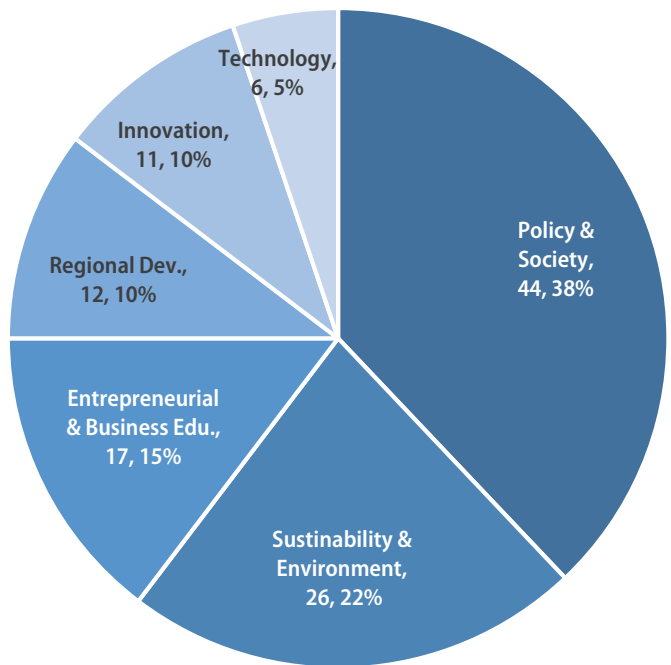
Since January 2017, the IC² Institute has produced 116 research publications. These data include works that are authored or co-authored by IC² staff (54.2%) or visiting scholars, and works that received financial support from the Institute. Co-authors are drawn from IC² fellows, students, and faculty from The University of Texas at Austin, and other institutions around the world. Many of these same authors are prolific in other academic fields, as well as providing opinion pieces to leading publications such as *The New York Times*. These publications are not included in this analysis.

The focus of these publications includes public policy and societal questions (38%); sustainability & environmental concerns such as cleantech and climate change mitigation (22%); entrepreneurial and business management education (15%); regional development (10%); innovation (10%); and technology (5%); and as seen the figure below. Forty-seven percent of these publications appear as refereed journal articles, 20% are books or book chapters, 17% are technical reports or monographs, and 16% were presented in conference. A bibliography of these titles follows, sorted by type.
